### **What is Attachment and Attachment Problems in Children?**

What is Attachment and Attachment Problems in Children? Children, like other living beings, are born with a drive to survive Infants do this by staying close to parents to get safety and be comforted when they are distressed When parents are protective and responsive children feel secure and develop a secure “attachment style”

### **Evaluating Cognitive and Behavioral Outcomes in ...**

Secure attachments are characterized by an ability to seek comfort from a caregiver when exposed to stress-inducing stimuli and then engage in play

**Attachment measures in children - Able-Differently**

Securely attached children are best able to explore when they have the knowledge of a secure base to return to in times of need. When assistance is given, this bolsters the sense of security and also, assuming the parent's assistance is helpful, educates the child in ...
