Other Specified Feeding or Eating Disorder • Symptoms characteristic of a feeding or eating disorder that cause clinical distress or impairment in social, occupational, or other important areas of functioning predominate • However DO NOT meet the full criteria for any of the disorders in the feeding and eating disorders diagnostic class

### **Cognitive Behavioral Therapy for Eating Disorders**

The “core psychopathology” of eating disorders is the over-evaluation of shape and weight • self-worth is judged largely or exclusively in terms of shape and weight and the ability to control them • other modes of self-evaluation are marginalised • most other features appear to be secondary to the core psychopathology • dieting
