However, an alarming consequence of these mental health conditions is the increased risk of self-harm and suicide in LGBT youth; research has revealed that LGBT youth are four times more likely to self-harm in comparison to their heterosexual peers, and four times more likely to self-harm with the intent of suicide.

While 27 per cent of post-secondary respondents said they have contemplated suicide, 30 per cent said they've considered quitting school and 29 per cent have considered self-harm.
